CITY COUNCIL EMERGENCY MEETING  
April 24, 2023

The city council met in emergency session on Monday, April 24, 2023 in the council chambers at city hall. Council President Schmidt called the meeting to order at 6:32 P.M. The emergency meeting had been set by notice dated April 18, 2023 for the purpose of approving a resolution declaring a state of emergency related to the spring flooding.

Council members present: Nathan Schmidt, Bryce Curtiss, Steve Sulflow, Dan Sanborn and Beverly Olson. Absent: None. Mayor Winter absent.

Staff present: City Manager Robert Wolfington and City Clerk Glennis Lauritsen.

City Manager Wolfington stated that as a result of the spring flooding, Chippewa County had declared a state of emergency, and it was recommended that the city take similar action.

DAN SANBORN OFFERED RESOLUTION NO. 3860, A RESOLUTION DECLARING A STATE OF EMERGENCY, AND MOVED ITS ADOPTION. MOTION FOR ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION NO. 3860 WAS SECONDED BY STEVE SULFLOW. THOSE VOTING IN FAVOR OF MOTION: DAN SANBORN, STEVE SULFLOW, BEVERLY OLSON, BRYCE CURTISS AND NATHAN SCHMIDT. THOSE VOTING AGAINST MOTION: NONE. RESOLUTION PASSED 5-0.
