

CITY OF MONTEVIDEO  
CITY COUNCIL WORKSESSION  
October 9, 2023

The city council met in a worksession on Monday, October 9, 2023 in the council chambers at city hall. President Schmidt called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. The worksession had been set by the council on October 2<sup>nd</sup> for the purpose of discussing future road improvement projects, and for any other business that might come before the council.

Council members present: Nathan Schmidt, Bryce Curtiss, Steve Sulflow, Dan Sanborn and Beverly Olson. Absent: None. Mayor Winter absent.

Also present was City Manager Robert Wolfington, City Engineer Mike Amborn, City Attorney Janice Nelson, Finance Director Jill Strand and Public Works Director Aaron Blom.

2. Discussion Items.

2(A) FUTURE ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS.

City Engineer Amborn distributed maps of proposed future road improvement projects, including:

- ▶ Oak Drive, Ridgeview Drive to Cul-de-sac - Full street reconstruction
- ▶ Summit Avenue, 3<sup>rd</sup> Street to 1<sup>st</sup> Street - Street reclaim and new bituminous pavement
- ▶ Black Oak Avenue, 17<sup>th</sup> Street to Runnings - 2023 Mn/DOT Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP)
- ▶ State Road, 1<sup>st</sup> Street to Case Avenue - 2025 Capital Improvement Planning

Amborn stated the Black Oak Avenue portion of the proposed project would be contingent on the City being successful in applying for a 2023 LRIP Grant, which would be awarded in March.

City Attorney Nelson provided an update on efforts to address the lack of plat for the street identified as State Road. Nelson said she is still working on serving property owners along State Road. Once that is complete, a Judge will ultimately determine the plat for State Road.
