

CITY OF MONTEVIDEO
CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
JANUARY 20, 2026

The city council met in regular session Tuesday, January 20, 2026 in the council chambers at city hall. Council President Curtiss called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Council members present: Steve Sulflow, Dan Sanborn, Dean Matthys and Bryce Curtiss. Absent: Beverly Olson. Mayor James Bulman present.

Also present were: City Manager Robert Wolfington, City Attorney Janice Nelson and City Clerk Tami Schuelke-Sampson.
